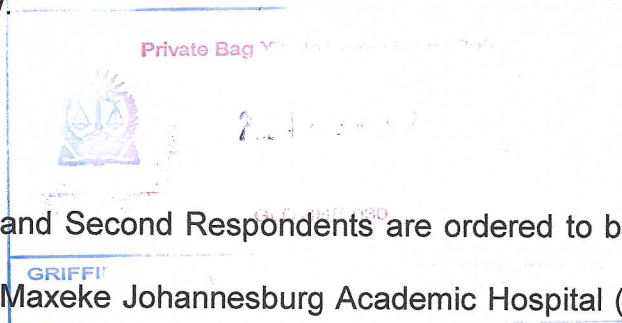
**DRAFT ORDER**

---

Having read the documents filed of record, heard counsel, having considered the matter, it is hereby ordered that:

1. That this application is enrolled on an urgent basis and that the forms and service provided for in the Rules of Court are dispensed with.

2. A rule nisi is issued calling upon the First, Second, and Third Respondents to show cause on Tuesday 24 March 2020 at 10:00 or soon thereafter as counsel may be heard why in order should not be made in the terms that follow.



3. The First and Second Respondents are ordered to be quarantined at the Charlotte Maxeke Johannesburg Academic Hospital ("CMJAH") until such time that the Department of Health ("DoH") is satisfied that the First and Second Respondents do not pose a risk of transmission of COVID 19 to the public.
4. The South African Police Service is ordered to trace the Third Respondent and that the Third Respondent be requested to be investigated by the DoH for possibly being infected with COVID 19. Until such time that the DoH is satisfied that the Third Respondent is not infected with COVID 19, the Third Respondent is to be quarantined at the CMJAH.
5. In the event that the Third Respondent refuses to be investigated for possibly being infected with COVID 19, the Third Respondent is ordered to be quarantined at CMJAH until such time as the DoH is satisfied that the Third Respondent does not pose a risk of possible transmission of COVID 19 to the public.

6. The Fourth Respondent is ordered to employ the services of tracing agents and to use cellular mobile service providers to trace the whereabouts and location of the First, Second, and Third Respondents.
7. The orders in prayers 3, 4, 5 and 6 are to operate as an interim order with immediate effect pending the return day.
8. The respondents may anticipate the return day on 24 hours notice to the applicants.
9. There is no order as to costs.
